

COOKIE POLICY

A cookie is a file that a website saves on your computer when you visit the site. Cookies enable the website to remember the actions and preferences of a user or a device, and, depending on the information they contain and on how you use your computer, can be used for user authentication. Your web browser stores cookies on the hard drive only during the current session. They take up very little storage space and do not harm the computer. Cookies do not contain any specific personal data, and most of them are erased from the hard drive when the browser session ends (session cookies).

Most browsers accept cookies automatically but you can change the security settings to enable or disable temporary and stored cookies.

Without your express consent –by enabling cookies in your browser– Fundación Luis Seoane will not use cookies to associate the data stored in them with the personal data you provided when you signed up or made a purchase.

What kind of cookies does this website use?

- Technical Cookies: These cookies allow the user to navigate a website, platform or application and to use the options or services available, such as controlling data traffic and communication, identifying a session, accessing restricted areas, carrying out a purchase, requesting a subscription or participating in an event, using security elements while browsing, storing content to broadcast video or sound or sharing content on social media.
- Personalisation Cookies: They allow the user to access services with certain pre-defined features such as language, browser type, regional settings, etc.
- Analytical Cookies: Either processed by us or by third parties, these cookies track the number of visitors and analyse how they use the website. The information collected by these cookies is then used to improve the services and products we provide.

Third Party Cookies: The Fundación Luis Seoane website may use third-party services whose cookies are used to collect information for statistical purposes, information on your browsing habits and to provide other services relating to the website's activity and other Internet services. This website uses Google Analytics, a web analytics service provided by Google, Inc., a US company located at Amphitheatre Parkway, Mountain View, California 94043. To provide their services, they use cookies that collect information, including the user's IP address, that will be sent, tested and stored by Google in the terms described at Google.com. This includes sharing information with third parties due to a legal requirement or when those third parties process data on behalf of Google.

By using this Site you agree to the processing of the data collected in the manner and for the purposes described above. And you acknowledge that you are aware that by adjusting the settings on your browser to disable Cookies you are refusing the processing of your data. Please note that disabling cookies may prevent you from being able to access certain features of our website.
