
HOW TO READ A FILM

During ten sessions, María Donapetry will guide participants into a like number of classics of cinema with the aim of analizing aspects such as the links between cinema and literature, the themes, the construction of dialogues, the editing, the visual metaphors or the impact on audiences. The students will receive a series of guidelines before watching the films, which they should do on their own to, later, take part in a conversation during which they will be encouraged to make brief presentations to develop their critical abilities and, most of all, to share their different points of view.
